Area of Learning	Tasks
Phonics and Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Sound hunt – find and collect objects from around the home that begin with each sound/letter</li><li>• Find your favourite books and read them to a sibling</li><li>• Watch the cbeebies bedtime story each evening (this can also be downloaded on bbc iplayer) and then draw the main character the next morning</li></ul>
Creative	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Design a new superhero – draw them, label them, write about what their powers are!</li><li>• Make your own playdough. Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Keep a diary of your days off school – this could be through drawing and labelling with words or captions</li><li>• Write about your favourite superhero – I like them because... Their powers are...</li></ul>
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Make your own 100 square</li><li>• Counting and sorting toys by colour, shape, textures etc.</li><li>• Write a number line 1-20</li><li>• Addition and subtraction with dried pasta or small toys</li><li>• Complete a puzzle</li><li>• Create your own puzzle by drawing a picture and cutting it into big shapes</li></ul>
